Present were Town Supervisor, Ann Rugg, Deputy Supervisor Dave Forster, Councilmembers: William Spors, Sidney Barber and Angela Sherman., Highway Superintendent Tom Benz, Clerk Deanna Bowen, and CEO Jeff Holler. Guests present were Bob Bowen, Chris Deyoe, Charles Herr, Tammi Herr, Mark Westfall, Chelease Lexer, Sean Lexer and Malanda Cambra.

A motion was made by Dave Forster and seconded by Sid Barber to authorize the Supervisor to pay all general and highway funds bills audited. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Forster and seconded by Bill Spors to approve and waive the reading of the June 12, 2018 meeting minutes. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Forster and seconded by Angela Sherman to accept the audit of June 2018 utility bills as presented. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried

Clerk paid to Supervisor \$342.70 for June 2018 fees and commissions collected.

Malanda Cambra spoke representing Armstrong providing fiber services into our area. When completed internet and telephone services will be available. The installation will be done over glass, 95% being done aerial on existing poles.

Hwy: Tom talked to the Town Justice, Cattaraugus Co. Sheriff and the Cattaraugus Co. DA and would like it on record that there is no arrest on file for him.

Tom had a company take a look at the well at the highway barns. The company put together a proposal with an estimate on changes that should be made. Discussion took place and Tom will contact another company for recommendations and quotes.

Cold mix is complete on Harvey Road.

Chip seal is set for the end of the month.

Six cones belonging to the Highway Department had to be replaced on Harvey Road after they came up missing. Tom suggested making out a police report regarding the theft of the cones. Ann agreed. Cones are labeled with EO HWY and anyone seeing these cones should make a phone call and report it.

The town truck was taken in for repair due to the water pump leaking.

Town Clerk: Deanna told the board the Revitalization Grant should be able to be applied for towards the demolition of the house on the property recently purchased by the town. She told the board Justice Young stated he could put in for a parking lot through the Justice Grant. Discussion took place regarding the removal of the house. Tammie Herr spoke representing the planning board and stated that if there was increased parking at the Town Hall there would be opportunity for more family entertainment. Some of the ideas the planning board has are outdoor movie nights, music, and an ice skating rink.

Supervisor: Discussion took place in regards to maintenance of the Town Hall and mulch for the playground.

Ann told the board of a new grant available from the County to be used for upgrading the baseball diamond. Tom stated that something needed to be done with the drainage.

CEO Report: Jeff completed 16 inspections, answered 12 phone calls, issued 4 permits, issued 1 violation notice and deposited \$350.00 to the clerk for permits issued.

A motion was made by Bill Spors and seconded by Angela Sherman to adjourn at 7:12 PM. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried.
