A motion was made by Bill Spors and seconded by Sid Barber to authorize the Supervisor to pay all general and highway funds bills audited. Spors, Barber, Sherman and Forster were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Sid Barber and seconded by Angela Sherman to approve and waive the reading of the July 10, 2018 meeting minutes. Spors, Barber, Sherman and Forster were in favor. Motion carried.

Clerk paid to Supervisor \$729.20 for July 2018 fees and commissions collected.

Hwy: The new truck will be delivered at the end of this August. The cab and chassis will be delivered the beginning of September. Dave asked about the old truck. Tom has been in contact with an Auction Company.

There has been some differences between the insurance adjustors and the insurance estimators.

Harvey road chipping is completely done.

Tom has placed an order for gravel for the gravel roads to be completed before winter.

Tom placed phone calls to 3 additional companies regarding the well at the highway shop. Two of the three companies came out and looked at the issues and gave an estimate. Discussion took place in regards to the well water at the shop. Dave made the recommendation that Tom call the health department and have them come test the water.

A motion was made by Sid Barber and seconded by Bill Spors to have the health department test the water at the highway shop. Spors, Barber, Sherman and Forster were in favor. Motion carried.

Town Clerk: Deanna told the board on the county website there are links for the town's dog license information. She has completed updating these links and Mary Dankert has been given log in information. Mary is able to check dog licenses through names and/or addresses of owners. This site tells if a dog license and/or rabies have expired.

Supervisor: Dave told the board GME finished the additional lighting from the Justice Grant. A proposal came back in regards to the playground for \$2,636 this would include new wood chips. Deanna told the board the small memory picnic table had been covered in bugs. She completely saturated it with a mixture of dish soap and water and as of now the bugs have not reappeared.

Tom told the board Chris Shattuck noticed a hole in the cupola and he asked him to repair it.

CEO Report: Jeff completed 9 inspections, answered 18 phone calls, issued 2 permits, attended court and deposited \$55.00 to the clerk for permits issued.

Public Comment: Sean Lexer spoke regarding the mowing of the new town property.

A motion was made by Sid Barber and seconded by Angela Sherman to adjourn at 7:15 PM. Spors, Barber, Sherman and Forster were in favor. Motion carried.
