Highway: Tom told the board that most of the patching has been done. NYS Association of Town was notified by NYS DOT that there will be a 20% reduction this year in CHIP Funds.

Town Clerk: Read a letter of resignation from Annemarie McCabe from the Board of Assessment Review.

A motion was made by Dave Forster and seconded by Sid Barber to accept the resignation from Annemarie McCabe. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor: The town received \$60,400 for the 2nd quarter sales tax.

A motion was made by Dave Forster and seconded by Sid Barber to approve Village Pressure Washing to pressure wash the Town Hall and the Playground for \$1,500.00 Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried

CEO Report: Jeff answered 22 phone calls, issued 6 building permits, did 13 Inspections, issued 2 addresses, 4 violation notices and deposited \$565 to the clerk.

A motion was made by Bill Spors and seconded by Angela Sherman to adjourn at 7:04 PM. Forster, Spors, Barber, Sherman and Rugg were in favor. Motion carried.
